

2022-2023 Board Game Club Skill Development Program Grades 3-5



TLDSB is offering in-person social skills intervention programs using Board Games. The 2022-2023 Board Game Club After School Skill Development Program will focus on learning the skills needed to play in a small social group format.

Who?

Students who are in Grades 3-5 during the 2022-2023 school year and who the school team feels would benefit from and participate in social skills instruction. Participating students must be motivated to participate in a group setting for 60 minutes once a week.

When?

Students will participate in 8 small group sessions for 60 minutes (April - June 2023). In-person sessions to occur in the City of Kawartha Lakes, Fenelon Falls, Haliburton, Gravenhurst, Bracebridge and Huntsville area schools. School Location TBD.

What does the program look like?

- Staffed by qualified special education personnel.
- A partnership with parents/guardians (and students) in order to enhance student participation and success.
- 60 minute group learning session in-person per week
- A report on student progress will be delivered at the end of the program (to home schools and families).
